SUPPLEMENT TO REFORT NO.

- Installations at the sea-plane base at Marienehe are shown in the diagram of attachment A. The area north of the coastal road, as that road passes over the sea-plane runway, is restricted, and there are two parking lots for Soviet trucks between the road and the water. The parking lots are designated as points 1 and 2 on enclosure A. A radio antenna is located on the roof of a building east of the parking lots. Radio tower is designated as point  ${}^{1}\!\!\Lambda^{n}$  on enclosure "A". A watchtower is located on the beach at point B. The jetty, point 4 on enclosure "A", is not used at present. A horizontal antenna, rotating about once a minute, is located on top of a building west of the runway and a small distance from the beach. This antenna is designated as point C on enclosure A.(L)
- Three cement blocks with mounted tracks are located on the coast near Markgrafen Heide. The site is positioned about 150 meters from the shoreline. The tracks appear to be movable and the higher ends are pointed out to sea. VP guards keep this area patrolled. (2) Sketch of this installation is attachment B.

Comment: The rotating antenna is probably a VHF-YAGI antenna.

Comment: The possibility that these ramps are for missle launching is weakened by the fact that they are guarded by the VP. However, they appear too complicated to be ordinary truck loading ramps.
