- Seven westbound shuttle trains with soldiers, coming from Gerdauen were listed in the records of the Kuestrin-Neustadt railroad station between 22 and 27 June 1951. The shuttle trains, whose destination could not be determined, were: No 113 of 44 boxcars on 22 June; No 119 of 20 boxcars on 22 June; No 108 of 24 boxcars on 23 June; No 118 of 54 boxcars on 25 June; No 109 of 53 boxcars on 26 June; No 104 of 54 boxcars on 26 June; and No 114 of 47 boxcars on 27 June. No westbound troop trains passed through the Kuestrin-Neustadt railroad station between 28 June and 3 July. *
 - Six eastbound shuttle trains with soldiers were listed in the records of the Kuestrin-Neustadt railroad station between 24 June and 1 July. The trains, which went to Instertburg, unless otherwise stated, were: No 112 of 53 boxcars from Weimar on 24 June; No 107 of 53 boxcars, origin and destination unknown, on 25 June; No 103 of 53 boxcars, origin and destination unknown, on 26 June; No 113 of 53 boxcars from Jueterbog on 27 June; No 108 of 57 boxcars from Jueterbog on 30 June; and No 101 of 52 boxcars from Dresden on 1 July. No troop trains were observed on 2 and 3 July. *
 - According to the records of the 5th Subdistrict Office of the Berlin railroad district, the following troop trains passed through the Rathenow railroad station between 13 and 22 July:

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* Comment. Shuttle-trains No 107, 108, 109, 125X1A, and 118 were also observed by another source in Kuestrin-Kietz. See Although there are several discrepancies regarding the composition of the trains and the dates, the present report generally confirms the reference report. Since shuttle-train No 119 was observed only once before, when passing through Kuestrin eastwards during the night of 17 June, it seems credible that the same train returned from Gerdaunen with recruits on 22 June. These movements of shuttle-trains No 103, 104, and 112 are reported for the first time. Shuttle-train No 113 was previously reported by another source to have hauled soldiers from Jueterbog to Kuestrin on 26 June. See . Shuttle-train No 101 was last reported when going empty from Wustermark to Jueterbog on 27 June. See . The present report indicates that the train went from Jueterbog to Dresden and was loaded there.

25X1A The other eight troop trains are reported for the first time. APNs 40358 and 40378 are assigned to artillery components of the 6th Arty Div in Rathenow.

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
