
In the spring of 1951 the Chinese Communist Military and Political Committee on Hainan Island divided the island into three sub-districts, exclusive of Ch'iungchou, Wench'ang, and Haik'cu, in order to suppress Nationalist guerrilla activities. It also established a branch in each of these sub-districts to supervise the suppression operations. The three sub-districts are organized as follows:

- a. The East Sub-District, composed of Hsin Min (), An Ting (), Wanning (110-23, 18-50), Lohui (110-27, 19-13), and Chiungtung (110-28, 19-23) Hsien, has its headquarters at Chiachi (110-24, 19-20) of Chiungtung Hsien.
- b. The West Sub-District, composed of Linkao (109-43, 19-56), Tan (109-16, 19-45), Ch'engmai (109-58, 19-47), and Paisha (110-17, 20-16) Hsien, has its headquarters in Linkao.
- c. The South Sub-District, composed of Yai (109-10, 18-24), Lingshui (109-56, 18-35), Ch'angkan (), Paot'ing (109-32, 18-40), and Lotung (109-10, 18-54) Hsien, has its headquarters at Yf An ()
