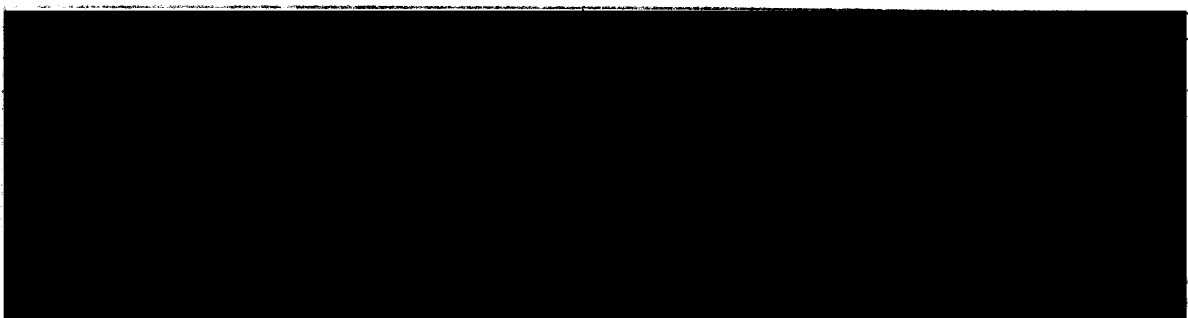

1. CHU Ming-ta (朱明達)<sup>1</sup>, director of the 3 Border Defense Sub-Bureau at Shumchun, has directed a trusted subordinate, WU Hun (巫焜), to make secret sales of permits for entry into China. An ordinary pass costs Hong Kong \$1.00 and enables the holder to go only to Canton and nearby places. Special passes enable the holder to go to various places within China, and the period of validity is longer.
2. WU Hun's assistant is a certain LU Hung-chun (陸鴻鈞). After coming to terms with prospective buyers at Sheungshui, WU sends LU back to Shumchun to arrange for the issuance of passes and entry permits at the Sub-Bureau office. The passes can be bought at any time by sending a person to buy them.
