Twelve thousand Japanese Kwantung army prisoners of war arrived in Mukden and Ch'angch'un from Khabarovsk and were integrated into the International Volunteer Army to participate in the Korean war. The Japanese unit is composed of one artillery regiment with the remainder infantry. Its commander is YOKOYAMA Isamu (横山勇), former Japanese major general. The unit has five Soviet Army colonels as advisors.
