1. In mid-May 1951, a low wooden barracks building, with a road leading to it and capable of quartering about 40 men, was constructed by soldiers on the eastern slope of Mt. Hengst, about 3 km northwest of Libstejn (Liebenstein) (M 51/P 27). \*
2. Prior to 24 May 1951, a new low wooden barracks building, about 50 meters long, was located on the summit of Mt. Dylen (Tillenberg) (N 50/P 46). Martial music was repeatedly heard from the direction of this building. Similar barracks buildings were located northeast of V. Mohelno (Neu Mugl) (N 50/P 45) and near Treppenstein (N 50/P 45).
3. In the afternoon of 23 May 1951, more than 50 heavy detonations were heard from the area north of Oldrichov (Ullrichsgruen) (N 50/P 46). Inhabitants of the border area were of the opinion that a surfaced road was being constructed to Mar. Lazne (Marienberg) (N 50/P 56). In the same border area a telephone line on wooden poles, 3 meters high, ran to Mar. Lazne and, [REDACTED] had been constructed between 15 and 22 May 1951. \*\*
