1. At a conference held at the Soviet Zone Directorate General, Railroads, on 23 June 1951, the representatives of all regional railroad headquarters were informed of an CCC directive, which ordered an immediate end to the scrapping of locomotives. No reason for this order was given. \*
  2. On 13 June 1951, it was learned at the Berlin regional railroad headquarters that the railroad depot in Berlin-Lichtenberg would soon receive enough materials to convert about 500 boxcars for troop transportation purposes. \*\*

- \* Comment. The scrapping of locomotives beyond repair was reported previously. See [redacted]. It remains to be seen whether efforts will be made to repair these locomotives, most of which suffered heavy damages during the war.

- \*\* Comment. The total stocks of such equipment available as of November 1950 and the excessive wear and tear to which this equipment is subjected was reported previously. See [redacted]. The report does not indicate whether the materials concerned were allocated from these stocks or newly manufactured.
