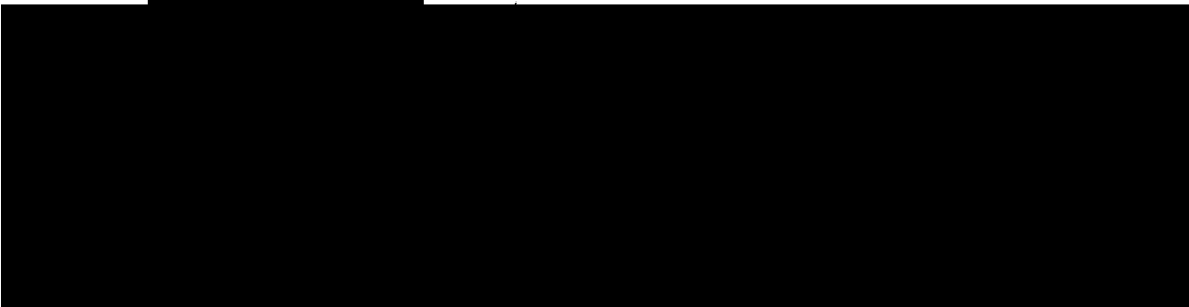

1. The following units of the 24th Air Army were observed flying on 3 September 1951:

- One fighter regiment each at Alt Lönnewitz, Grossenhain, Neuruppin, and Finow.
- One transport regiment at Altenburg, which was engaged in an air-drop exercise.

2. The following units were observed flying on 4 September:

- Two fighter regiments at Alt Lönnewitz.
- One fighter regiment each at Dessau, Parchim, Finow, Neuruppin, Poenemünde, Wittstock, Neubrandenburg, Köthen, Brandenburg-Briest, Brandis, and Grossenhain.
- One ground-attack regiment each at Schönwalde and Brandenburg-Arado.
- Three other ground-attack regiments.

3. The following units were observed flying on 5 September:

- Two fighter regiments each at Grossenhain, Köthen, and Lärz.
- One fighter regiment each at Alt Lönnewitz, Dessau, Parchim, Brandenburg-Briest, Brandis, Finow, Wittstock, and Neubrandenburg.
- Two bomber regiments at Jüterbog-Altes Lager and one at Cranienburg.
- One transport regiment at Altenburg.
