1. After observing loading operations at the Potsdam (N 53/2 69) freight yard on 11 July 1951, source determined that both the barracks installation in Kraspnitz and the engineer section of the Delius Kaserne had apparently been completely emptied.*
2. On the morning of 25 July, a train of 12 boxcars and 35 flatcars was loaded at the Potsdam freight yard. Six motor vehicles and 37-mm AA guns were loaded. The vehicles included 1 marked with the artillery emblem; 5 trucks F 5-4
