25X1C 1. On 25 July 1951, the two Artillerie Kasernen on either side of Berlinerstrasse, Prenzlau (N 5h/3 lh), were occupied by only 10 to 15 officers and about 150 men. The number of officers substantially increased after mid-July. The personnel of the guard detail occasionally received field training in the neighboring terrain and practiced at the target range. From 30 to 40 troops were observed at a time. German workmen were reconditioning the barracks installations. [REDACTED] were seen hauling coal from the railroad station to the installations throughout the day.

25X1C 2. When entering the Artillerie Kasernen on 26 July, [REDACTED] only a rear unit of 2 officers and about 50 men. Since the soldiers were billeted in all of the barracks buildings, source concluded that a small detail of each unit had remained. German workmen were engaged in minor repair work. * 25X1A

25X1C * Comment. The component units of the 25th Tank Div and Fourth Gds Mecz Army from the two barracks installations were still at the regular troop training grounds at the end of July 1951. [REDACTED]
