- (2). Antung: 32 MIG-15's with Pel-pei-lich-yeh-fu and Wei-ssu-ya-k'o (維其重力) as flight leaders.
- 6. On 27 August CCAF training missions were as follows:
  - a. K'aiyuan: a number of planes with MA Chieh-shen as flight leader.
  - b. Teingtac: a number of MIG-15's of the 46 Air Regiment and 21 MIG-15's of the 46 Air Regiment on cross country flights.
  - c. Shangbai: 17 fighters and 2 bombers.
- 7. On 27 August SAF training missions were as follows:
  - a. Kungchuling: a number of MIG-15's and one YAK-17.
  - b. Mukden: 43 MIG-15's in 2 groups with Hao-lao-to-fa and LIE Hu as flight leaders.
  - c. Lieoyang: 25 MIG-15's and one YAK-11 with LI Kno-chih as flight leader.
  - d. Anshen: 5 LA-11's, 2 LA-9's, and one YAK-11 with Yeh-fei-map-fu as flight leader.
