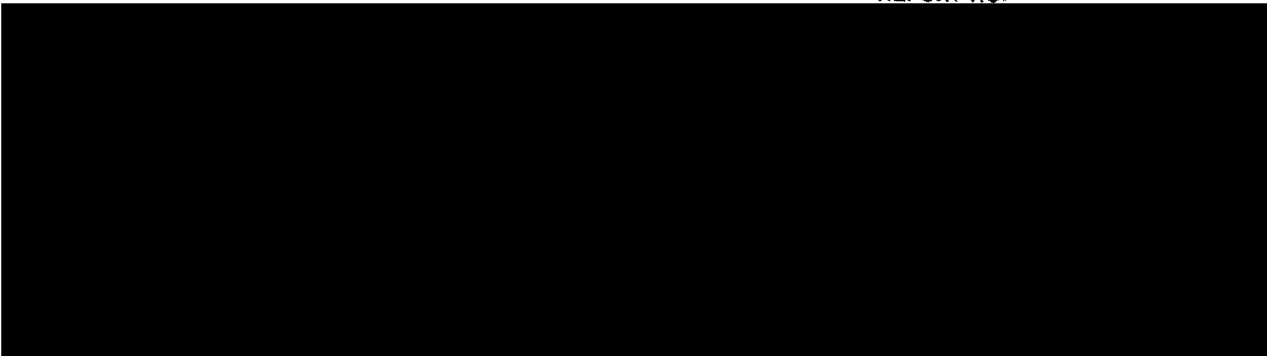

1. Exclusive of its suburbs, the town of Ananov (4743N, 2957E), Ukrainian SSR, covers an area about 800 to 1000 meters wide and 1 to 1.5 kilometers long. The town itself has a population of 10,000, with an additional 20,000 people being settled in four nearby suburbs. Most of the population consists of native Russians and Moldavians.

2. The railroad station for Ananov is at Zherobkovo, 15 km northwest of the town. Source states that large reservoirs of petroleum, gasoline, and turpentine are stored at Zherobkovo for use in Ananov. Some of these reservoirs are above ground, others partly underground.

25X1X 5X [redacted] informed by inhabitants of the town that 8000 to 10,000 Soviet Army artillery men are stationed at Ananov. These troops are moved out of the town each summer in the direction of the Moldavian SSR.

25X1X 4.5 [redacted] attached town plan of Ananov with the following details numbered and described:

1. Zherobkovo Hill, which reaches a height of 120 m.
2. Odessa Hill, which reaches a height of 150 m.
3. Milygul stream, 3-5 m wide, 1.5-2 m deep in winter, flowing into sea near Odessa.
4. Town of Ananov. Streets numbered 16 to 23 are brick paved, 6-8 m wide, with sidewalks on both sides about 2 m wide.
5. Forest about 8-10 km wide.
6. Zherobkovo railroad station.
7. Railroad line to Odessa.
8. Railroad line to Pervomaisk.
9. Road connecting town with railroad station. Road is 15 km long, 3-10 m wide, paved with stone bricks.
10. Gravel road connecting Ananov with Odessa, 200 km long, 5-6 m wide.
11. Suburb of Ananov extending about 4 km west of the town.
12. Suburb of Ananov extending about 6 km east of the town.
13. Suburb of Ananov extending 5-6 km southeast of the town.
14. Suburb of Ananov extending about 4 km southwest of the town.
15. Stalina Street, 8-10 m wide, brick paved, sidewalks on each side.
16. Ananovo Street
17. Revolyutsii Street
18. Krasnoi Armii Street

20. Bolnichnaya Street
21. Pushkinskaya Street

23. Miliomaya Street
24. Wooden bridge, 30 m long, 5-6 m wide.
25. Machine Tractor Station containing two single-story brick buildings, one 50 x 15 m, the other about 15 x 6 m. Eighty to a hundred laborers work here.
26. Three storage tanks, 15-20 ton capacity, for petroleum, gasoline, and turpentine. They are partly underground.
27. Roof tiles factory employing about 100 workers from May to October each year.
28. Army barracks: one-story brick building about 20 x 6 m in size. saw 20-25 anti-tank guns in the large yard around the building and noted tanks of various sizes towing three or four such guns.
- 25X1B 29. Military building: one-story, brick, about 100 x 10 m. In the yard here many army vehicles which were rumored to be used for transportation of men and ammunition.
- 25X1B 30. Army barracks: two-story, brick, approximately 70 x 40 m with a yard about 200 x 300 m. 50-60 anti-tank guns in this yard.
31. Brick building, two-story, about 15 x 10 m, said to be used for MVD offices.
32. Military warehouse: two-story, brick, approximately 70 x 10 m. The upper floors contain military supplies and the basement stores foodstuffs. There are 15-20 guns in the yard.
33. Town government building: brick, about 15 x 25 m, one-story.
34. Local Communist Party offices: one-story brick building, 25 x 10 m.
35. Post office: one-story, brick, about 15 x 15 m.
36. Military barracks: one-story, brick building, about 50 x 10 m.
37. Town bank: one-story, brick, about 15 x 10 m.
38. Square where town market and church are located.
39. Gunnery training area.
40. Town prison: one-story, brick, surrounded by a brick wall 50 x 40 x 3 m.
