



SUPPLEMENT TO 25X1X REPORT NO.



- The sirfield at Dzhambul (4255N, 7123E), Kazakh SSR, is located 3 to 4 kilometers northwest of the city and 1 to 1.5 kilometers west of the railroad Turning from Dehembul to Tashkent.
- The cirfield, about 1000 meters long and 500 meters wide, is enclosed by a wire feace. The field's surface is grass, and there are no runways. 25X1X the field is being used by cadets from the air school in the 25X1X about thirty planes of the Douglas and Kukuruznik types in use there.
 - E. The sirfield at Knyazhpogost (6238N, 5050E), Komi ASSR, is located in a wooded area west of the town. The field has a sandy surface and one asphalt runway about 150 meters long and 4 meters wide. The field is used in all seasons of the year.
 - 4. Planes of the Kukuruznik and Douglas types were seen at the Enyazhpogost cirfield. Other planes there were used for detecting forest fires and for observing the flow of rivers.
 - 5. The sirfield at Vozbayel (6251N, 5121E), Komi ASSR, is located about 500 naters west of the town. It is egg-chaped, about 1.5-2 kilometers at its langest point and I kilometer at its widest. The surface of the field is sandy and there is no indication of a runway.
 - 6. The Vorhayel airfield includes a two-story wooden headquarters building, two semi-underground stores for oil and gasoline, a hangar for plane repairs, and wireless equipment. The field is used in all seasons.
