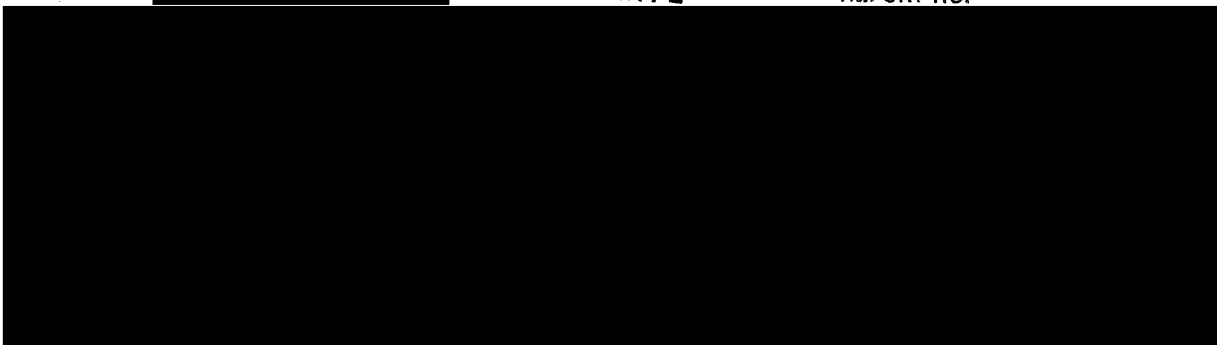

During the period from 24 June to 31 July 1951 the Chinese Communists imported the following supplies through the port of Macao:

- b. Lubricating oil 6,846 drums
- c. Rubber tires (34x7) 4,213 tires (34 x 7)
- d. Rubber tires for military use 5,874 tires
- e. Rubber 4,136 tons
- f. Metals 33,679 tons
- g. Medicine 208,954 boxes (about 1 cubic foot)
- h. Machinery 367 boxes
- i. Automobile parts 2,463 boxes
- j. Electrical equipment 868 boxes
- k. Radio sets 148 sets (American-made)
- l. Aircraft parts 1,132 boxes
- m. Acid 246 bottles
- n. Chemicals and TNT 2,146 boxes
- o. Film 683 boxes
