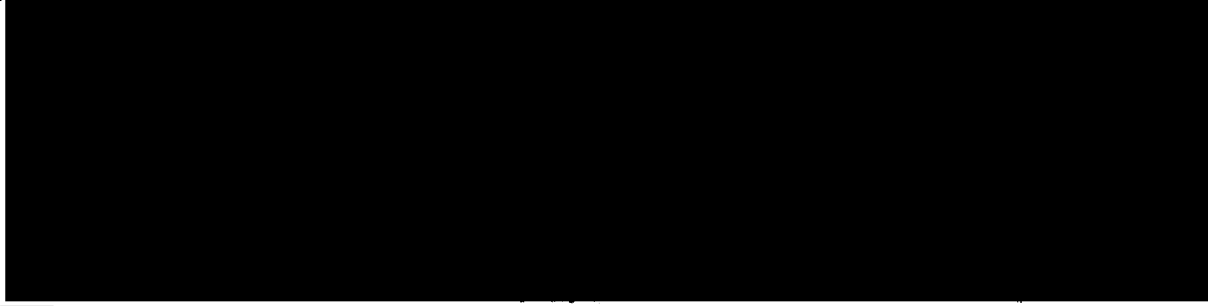

- On 1 and 2 September, a total of 1,500 Soviet women between 16 and 25 years old arrived at the Messenger Station in Frankfurt an der Oder. Some of the women wore dark-blue uniforms. They departed aboard Soviet leave trains going in various directions. (1)
 - On 3 September 1951, one train of 38 cars carrying troops, 37 mm AA guns, 22 motor vehicles, and field kitchens, passed through Kuestrin and proceeded to Cottbus via Frankfurt an der Oder. (2)
 - Two troop trains, one on 3 September and one on 4 September, with a total of 21 boxcars and 73 flatcars, were seen passing from Dallgow-Doeberitz to Jueterbog-Altes Lager. (3)
 - One troop train with 13 boxcars and 48 flatcars went from Neustrelitz to Luckenwalde on 5 September. (4)
 - One troop train with 14 boxcars and 42 flatcars went from Forst Zinna to Neuruppin on 6 September. (5)

- (1) [REDACTED] Comment: The arrival of Soviet women has been periodically reported since mid-August. Women have constituted about ten percent of the personnel aboard leave trains. They are probably being used to replace German civilians employed by Soviet troop units.

- (2) [REDACTED] Comment: The origin point of this train could not be determined.

- (3) [REDACTED] Comment: These trains may have carried a component of the First Mechanized Division to the Jueterbog area for training.

- (4) [REDACTED] Comment: This train may have carried an artillery component of the Ninth Guards Tank Division since another source observed thirty 100 mm artillery pieces and other vehicles of that division when they were unloaded from a troop train in Josefwalde (sic) on 5 September.

- (5) [REDACTED] Comment: These soldiers were probably a component of the Twelfth Guards Tank Division returning to its home station. Paragraphs 2 and 3 of this report indicate the continuation of the rotation of units of the Second Guards Mechanized Army to the Jueterbog - Luckenwalde area since the end of June.
