25X1A 1. [REDACTED] ten fighter aircraft equipped with in-line engines and two biplanes were stationed at Parndorf (P 48/X 77) airfield. There was no flying. Twenty tents each with a capacity of eight to twelve men were pitched beside the low wooden buildings. Six trucks, two tank trucks, two van-like trucks, and a wrecker were observed.

2. According to a local female interpreter, about 100 men arrived at Parndorf railroad station on 19 June at 7:05 a.m. by train from Hegyeshalom (P 48/Y 06), the Hungarian border crossing station. These men were marched from the railroad station to the airfield.
