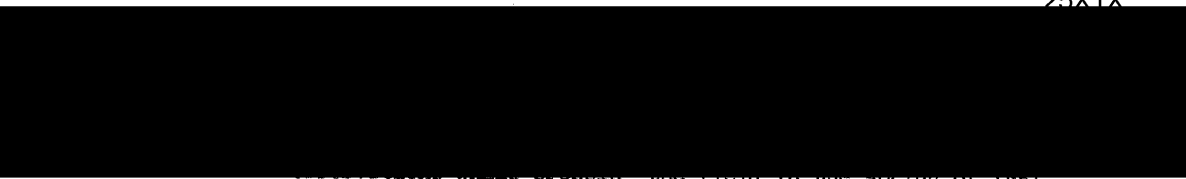

1. During World War II, a modern airfield with cement runways and concrete bunkers was constructed in a wooded area just south of the Sochaczew (Q 53/P 48)-Warsaw railroad line, and southwest of Szymanow (R 53/P 58) railroad station. The outlying part of Gaj (R 53/P 58) farm was located in the middle of the field. The field was destroyed during the war. Up to the fall of 1950, no clearing or reconditioning work had been done. Cement blocks were scattered over the field.

2. Source confirms the information of the source of paragraph 1 as to the location and status of the airfield. Since he did not observe any clearing work he believed that the field was not serviceable. *

* Comment. The report refers to the former German Air Force airfield called Topolowa. The information that the field was destroyed is credible. It is not known whether there are runways at Topolowa airfield.
