- 1. On 20 August 1951 the Northeast China Military Area Command (NECMAC). including all offices of the political department, firsace and supply units of the Supply and Service Command and the police guard regiment, suddenly moved to T'awan (場場), west of Huangkut'un (123-22, 41-48). KAO Kang was still in the Mukden area; therefore deputy commander HO Chin-nien (資資子) and CHOU Huan (最 於), head of the political department, were in charge of the entire headquarters.
- 2. This is the second time that the NECMAC has moved to T'awan since the start of the Korean war. The first time was in February, for the announced reason of being a precaution against United Nations air raids on Mukden. The NECMAC returned to Mukden in May.
