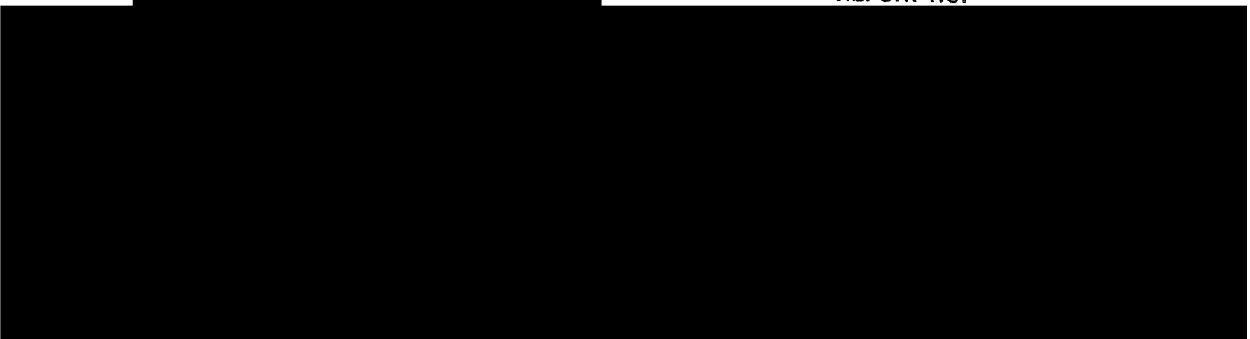

1. In accordance with the Sino-Soviet Military Pact the following three special military districts were established and are now under Sino-Soviet military control, except for civil administration which is still exclusively under Chinese control:

- a. Ashan (阿山) Special Military District in Sinkiang.
- b. Tsingtao Special Military District.
- c. East Chekiang Special Military District.

The East Chekiang Military District Headquarters at Tinghai (122-06, 30-03) is under the command of SU Yu,¹ commander of the 3 Field Army, and has as deputy commander Similenko, a Soviet major general. The Chief of Staff is Soviet Major General Soevsky and the Deputy Chiefs of Staff are Soviet Colonel Shalovits² and Chinese Communist officer LIANG Hsin (梁新). The commander of Soviet and Chinese Forces in this district is Soviet Major General Shemontenov and the deputy commander is CHANG Hung-wen (章洪闻). The commander of Soviet and Chinese Communist Naval Forces in this district is Soviet Navy Captain Chinekov and the deputy commander is Chinese Communist CHU Jui (朱瑞). The Commander of Soviet and Chinese Communist Air Forces in this district is Soviet Colonel Bukoyan and the deputy commander is LIN CHI (林德) who was formerly assigned to an aviation school in Manchuria. The head of Service and Supply is a Soviet lieutenant colonel and the deputy head is LU K'un (陆堃).

3. The East Chekiang Military District is divided into three sub-districts with the following commanders and deputy commanders:

- a. The Choushan Islands-Saddle Islands sub-district is under the command of General JEN Hung-tee (任洪泽) and the deputy commander is a Soviet colonel.
- b. The Yungen (甬南) sub-district comprises Chenhaihsien (121-42, 29-58), Ningpo, Fenghuahsien (121-23, 29-41), and Hsiengshan (121-59, 29-29). Soviet Colonel Sirochev is the commander and P'AN Yu-wen (潘友文) is the deputy commander.
