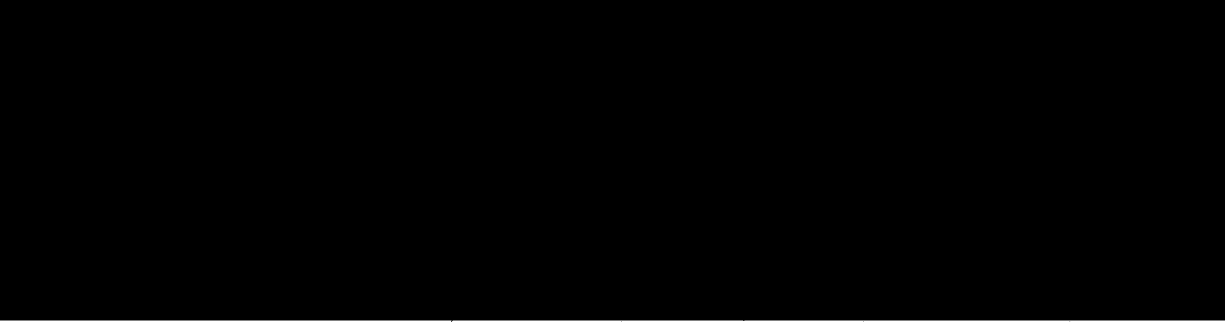

- At the beginning of 1951 workers at the Skoda Works in Pilsen were told to expect the arrival of Soviet workers who were coming to teach them Soviet methods of production. It is believed that this may be an attempt to camouflage the movement of Soviet troops into the western area of Czechoslovakia. An increasing number of Soviet troops are reported in the Pilsen, Pahrinov (050/M41) and Pocatky (050/M40) areas.
- Large-scale evacuations of Czech troop barracks have been reported from the western border area since the first of the year. The Czech troops have been moved to emergency billets in factories and wooden huts.
