Training missions on 3 September 3:

- a. Mutanchiang: a Type-99 trainers, 2 YAK-91s, 1MIG-15, 1 Type-2 trainer and 5 other planes flew.
- b. At Hailang, Wenchun and Lankang Airfields in the Nutanchiang area a total of 349 Chinese Communist pilots participated in take-off and landing practice.
- c. One military transport flew to Lungan, Liaoyangand back to Changchun at an altitude of 5,600 feet.
- d. At Liaoyang 27 MIG-15°s with LI Kuo-chih as flight leader, flew at an altitude of 40,000 feet.
