Because Bulgarian Railroads do not allow an axle load of over thirteen tons, the Main Directorate for Yugoslav Railroads, on 6 June 1951, ordered all Yugoslav railroad stations to observe Bulgarian regulations. That part of the railroad line Svilengrad-Pythion is affected by the regulation and it therefore concerns all goods transiting Bulgaria [redacted] 50X1-HUM

2. By order of the Yugoslav Main Railroad Directorate, Yugoslav frontier railroad stations are not permitted to receive any foreign car whose axle load exceeds thirteen tons which has to transit Bulgaria [redacted] 50X1-HUM
