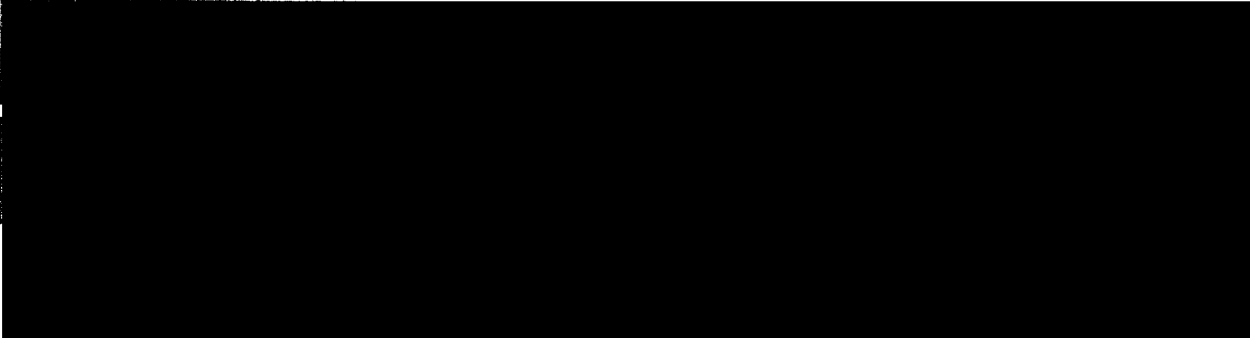

1. On the east side of the district road between Bochov (N51/P78) and Touzim (N51/P77) just north of Prilezy (N51/P77) (sic) is a wooden hut 4 m by 12 m in size surrounded by a barbed-wire fence. Into this hut lead two high-frequency telephone lines from Prague and twelve high frequency military telephone lines. The hut is under the control of a military unit of 7 to 20 men stationed in Prilezy. Telephone switchboards are located in a room built underground under the hut and entered by means of a trapdoor in the floor of the hut. This building was used by the Germans during the occupation as a telephone central.
2. On the east side of the road to Touzim about 200 m south of Prilezy is a radar station consisting of a rectangular bedspring-like antenna about 15 m long and between 8 and 10 m high. About 15 m from this antenna are four bowl-like antennas, about 3 m in diameter. This station is operated by the military unit in Prilezy. The radar station was built by a group of employees from the Skoda Works in Pilsen about the beginning of October 1950. The installation is believed to be connected by telephone with the exchange described above. A similar installation is located near the Stedra railroad station (N51/P87).
3. A military dump covering an area of about 600 m by 80 m and surrounded by a barbed-wire fence is located about 350 m south of the road between Bochov and Hemecky Chloumek (N51/P70) about 3 km from Bochov.
