- On 1 September 1951, the Democratic Republic of Vietnam (DRV) opened a military training course for approximately 5,000 cadres, selected chiefly from Central Vietnem. Training classes are to be held at Cao Bang, Kwangyuml and Fuhuc2, under the direction of HUANG Chun-kuo (黃春頃)3, a 48-year old native of Nghe An.
- Headquarters for the course has been established at Lao Kuan Wei (老堂員), 4 Po Kung Chieh (波角红色), in the city of Cao Bang. The headquarters staff includes Chinese Communist advisors who participate in the administration of the course and in the formulation of policy. Half of the instructors are also Chinese Communists.
- The students have been organized into 18 companies (Dai Doi), of about 250 men each. These include 3 artillery and 5 demolition companies at Fuhua, 2 communications or transport companies at Kwangyan and 2 political training, 5 infantry and 1 signal companies at Gao Bang.
