- 1. In early August 1951, the South China Trade Bureau sent JEI China (), a trade specialist, to the Nan Kuang Company in Macao to supervise their purchasing of war materials.
- 2. The Han Kuang Company rented the former Luk Yue (] Restaurant, 118-120 Rua Almirante Sergio, and turned it into a branch office, They also obtained 8 licenses to carry arms in addition to the 16 which they had obtained in the past. In early August they were sending to the Chinese mainland about 200 tons of war materials daily, including rubber and petroleum products. The firm had obtained about 2,000 tons of rubber through Portuguese merchants. The purchase was made in Halaya and the rubber was shipped to Hacao by way of Timor.
- 3. HO Hsien, LIANG Chiang and KiO Chang-plung rented the SS TA UNI (大美) to operate between Borneo and Macao. The vessel, of about 1,500 tons, has the letter "M" painted on its funnel. The captain is Portuguese, and MSU Nung (新美) is the manager.1
- 4. On 3 August 1951 HO Heien, using the name of the Tung Fu (局 紀) Company, sold 60 tires (900 x 20) to the Han Kuang Company.
- 5. Chinese Communists representatives in Hong Kong purchased here than 200 Germanmado miniature comerno from the Ta Chinan Company. This ty of these were smuggled from Hong Kong to Hacao on 21 July 1951, and were received by the Timg Tiai () Company. The cameras were priced at HK 0500. With a maximum dimension of four inches, they can be focussed to as little as four feet and have a shutter speed of 1/1,000 second. Special film for making exposures under adverse lighting conditions was also obtained.
- 6. The manager of the Ta Chiang Company, which for erly was a purchasing agency for the Chinese Communists, abscorded with some of the company's funds and the company was forced to close down,
- 7. On 3 August the junk JUNG HOING leaded DLC 50-gallon drums of gasoline at Tharf 23, Macao, and departed for Kongmoon. On the same day the junk CHIN CHING took 250 drums of gasoline to Kongmoon.

- 8. From 3 to 5 August 1951 the following shipments were made from Macao to Canton:
 - 3 August: 1,000 drums of gasoline and 100 tons of wire, on the barge KUANG FU LUNG, 300 tons, license number 1540 V.
 - 4 August: 460 drums of gasoline, 30 tons of angle (sic) bars, 250 100-kilogram bundles of rubber, 20 200-pound bags of rubber scrap, on the junk KUEI NAN, which loaded at Tharf 34.
 - 5 August: 300 200-pound bundles of zinc plates and 500 200-pound reals of whre, on the SS P'ING AN, which loaded at harf ob on 4 August.
