1. The secretariat of the SDA Central Council at 29 Stuttgarter Strasse, Frankfurt/Main, is staffed with five to seven functionaries. They carry the title of secretaries and are in charge of the various sections. The organization section is headed by Fritz Pospiech, the enterprise and mass organization section by Horst Boje, the indoctrination section and the youth section by Hans Thiel, and the somen's section by Mrs. Pospiech. There is also a secret section which deals with matters pertaining to the SPD. Its secretary is still to be appointed.

It is planned that the Central Council shall be composed of 45 delegates from the various State Councils, including four delegates from Schleswig-Holstein, two from Hamburg, eight from Lower Sexony and Bremen, eight from North-Rhine-Westphalia, four from Hesse, six from Rhineland-Palatinates two from the Sear, eight from Bavaria and six from Wuerttemberg-Badon-Hohemsollern.
- 3. It is planned that the various State Councils shall be composed of the following personnel:
  - a. Schleswig-Holstein: one Landesleiter, two instructors and 14 council members.
  - b. Hamburg: one Landesleiter, one instructor and 11 council members.
  - c. Lower Saxony-Bremen: one Landesleiter, four instructors and 23 councils members.
  - d. North-Rhine-Westphalia: two Landesleiter, four instructors and 23 council members.
  - e. Hesse: one Landesleiter, two instructors and 14 council members.
  - f. Rhineland, Palatinate, Saar: one Landesleiter, four instructors and 23 council members.
  - g. Bavaria: one Landesleiter, four instructors and 23 council members.
  - h. Wuerttemberg, Baden, Hohenzellern: one Landesleiter, three instructors and 21 council members.

4. The SDA is financed by the KPD, with couriers picking up the money at various places, frequently at Duesseldorf and Stuttgart. SDA functionaries who went to Stuttgart for this purpose on 21 July 1951 included Horst Doje, Fritz Pospiech, and a driver. Their arrival was announced by telegram which read: "Arriving at 6. Stop. Inform Albert. Stop. Robert." \*

Corrent: The Albert mentioned in the telegram is possibly Albert Buchmann, KPD chairman in Wuerttemberg-Baden, who plays a important role in the SDA, although personally he remains in the background. Robert is a KPD functionary permanently attached in a liaison capacity to the SDA office at 29 Stuttgarter Strasse, Frankfurt.
