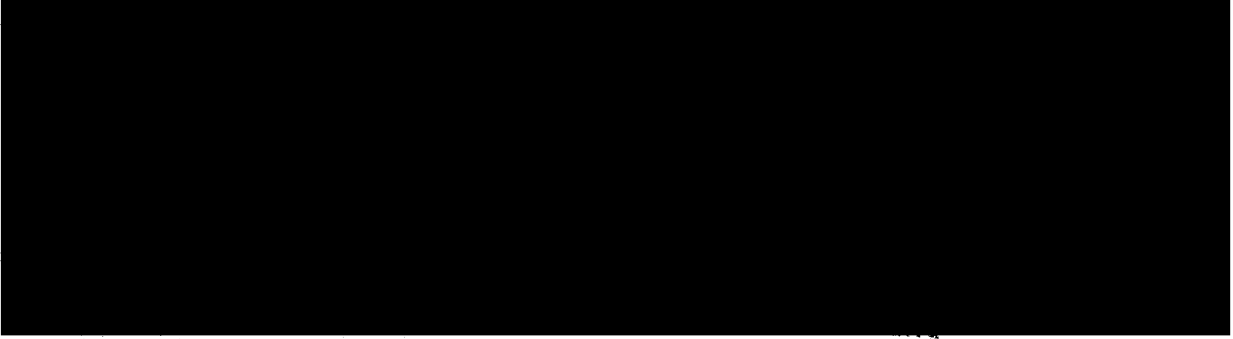

1. LI Chu-li (李初梨), representative of LIU Shao-ch'i, YANG Wen-ch'ing (楊文清), representative of CH'EN Keng, and their driver were injured and their car wrecked by a grenade thrown by a guerrilla. LI was wounded in the left arm and shoulder, and YANG's face was bruised. The incident happened when they were returning to Canton from YEH Chien-ying's residence in Mei Hua Ts'un (梅花村) via the Canton - Yü Chau (魚珠) highway.
2. Communist troops were rushed to Mei Hua Ts'un and martial law was declared.
3. LI and YANG had come to Canton to discuss the military conference to be held in late July in Peiping which was to consider aid for the Indochinese People's Liberation Army. On the night of 13 July they dined with YEH Chien-ying and held a secret meeting on the forthcoming conference. PAO Te-ning (保大平), commander of the liberation army, and CH'EN Man-yuan (陳曼遠) and CHUANG T'ien (光田), representatives of CHANG Yun-i, were also present.
