Legend to Annex 

- 1 Radio installation with one mast, inner beacon, permanently occupied by 5 or 6 soldiers
- 2 Radio installation with one mast about 12 meters high
- 3 Radio installation with 4 masts, each 8 to 10 meters high and in the middle of them a mast about 5 meters high fitted on a box-like base.
- 4 Radio installation with one mast (outer beacon). Nine soldiers were observed there. This installation was previously located in the gravel pit southeast of its present location.  
Note. The four radio installations, items 1 through 4, were exactly in-line with the old runway.
- 5 Wooden shed
- 6 Wooden shed
- 7 Two water reservoirs (swimming pools ?)
- 8 Several wooden sheds and a Dumbo type radar set surrounded by a board fence
- 9 Concrete building, possibly an aircraft target range
- 10 Stripped Soviet aircraft
- 11 Two fuel dumps, with a total of about 50 containers having capacities from 5,000 to 20,000 liters. The total storage capacity of the dumps was estimated at 500 cubic meters
- 12 Billeting area for Soviet dependents
- 13 Two Soviet shops and a warehouse
- 14 Telephone line
- 15 Electric line.
