When the Chinese Communists took over Peiping, the president of the Catholic Fujen (輔仁) University was CH'EN Yuan (陳垣) a non-Catholic, but non-Communist. CH'EN went over to the Communist side, as a result, probably, of the influence of his eldest son, a Communist Party member, and became an ardent supporter of Communist policies. The registrar of the university was a Communist and proved to be an important figure in the Communist policy regarding the university. The actual power at the university fell into his hands.
