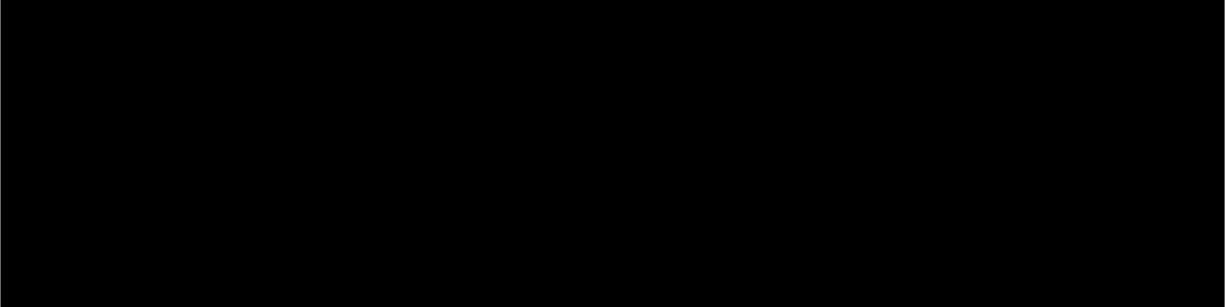

1. It is expected that a large number of delegates and guest representatives of sympathizer groups will attend the Vienna meeting of the World Peace Council to be held 1-6 November 1951. Jean Lafitte, secretary general of the Prague office of the World Peace Council and his assistant Penoaltis\* have been ordered to give maximum support to the forthcoming meeting. The Prague, Warsaw, Paris and Moscow offices are expected to help procure interpreters of Middle and Far Eastern languages.
2. The meeting site has not yet been decided. The Vienna representatives of the World Peace Council approached Stefan Varga, proprietor of the Droher-Park\*\*, Vienna 12, but learned that the left-wing Socialists had reserved the Droher-Park for their party caucus of 3-4 November 1951, since the World Peace Council meeting was originally scheduled for October 1951. If the Droher-Park is not available, the Peace Council may rent the Kuenstlerhaus, Vienna 1 or the Konzerthaus, Vienna 3, Lothringergasse 20. Frau Lehr\*\*\* is responsible for renting the space. Architect Sussman\*\*\*\* is in charge of the decorations. The facilities will include earphones relaying translated speeches.
3. The representatives of the World Peace Council intend to institute thorough checks of the meeting site entry to prevent the attendance of unauthorized persons.
4. A mass meeting open to the public has been proposed for the last day of the session. No decision has been reached regarding this proposal.
