SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

1. The police in Surabaya have sent warning notices to teachers in some 20 local Chinese schools. This action is specially directed against the Lian Chung Middle School at Dj. Ngeaplak and the Sin Hua School at Dj. Ngalik, Surabaya. The notices contain the following points:
 - a. Unregistered Chinese schools must carefully observe the regulations governing such schools; otherwise they will be forced to close.
 - b. Politics should not be taught in the schools.
 - c. Propaganda of any political ideology must not be introduced into the schools.
 - d. Criticism of the Government should not be directly or indirectly encouraged.
 - e. Posters and slogans should not be displayed in any part of the school premises, especially those posters containing propaganda detrimental or offensive to a foreign country.
 - f. Students should not be prohibited from attending the exhibition of American films, because Indonesia guarantees freedom to all citizens.
2. In one of the Chinese schools an anti-British, anti-American poster was confiscated. The slogan, "All the World's Youth must Rise and Unite Together into One" was printed on it in Chinese.
