The Warnowwerft at Warnemünde has released or transferred 3,000 of its 7,000 employees. Some workers at the shipyard in Stralsund have been transferred to steelworks in Lower Saxony and Brandenburg. The SAG Neptunwerft in Rostock has released 400 workers and the VVW Ernst Thälmann VEB in Brandenburg has released 320 workers. The Tangermünderwerft has released 80 workers. The VVW Schiffsreparaturwerft VEB, Wismar has also reduced the number of its employees.
