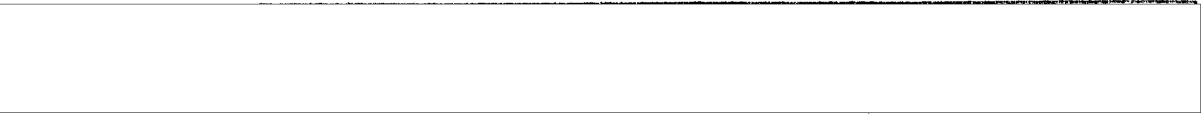

1. The Deutscher Innen- und Aussenhandel-Ost (German Inland and Foreign Trade-East) (DIA), previously DAAA, received the following deliveries for the Oberspree Cable Plant Metals Department, at 76-77 Wilhelmshofstrasse, Berlin-Oberschoene-weide: 25X1
 - a. On 22 June and 10 July 1951, from Europe Commerce and European Trading Company, Copenhagen, a total of 38,970 kg of metallurgic soft lead, 99.9 percent pure, at an authorized price of 23.10 DM per percentage kg plus a 2 percent commission, or a total of 9,182.11 DM.
 - b. On 30 June and 16 and 27 July 1951, a total of 57,480 kg of metallurgic soft lead, 99.9 percent pure, of UH and Kayser types from Socorex, S.A., 3 rue St. Pierre, Lausanne, at an authorized price of 23.10 DM per percentage kg plus a 2 percent commission or a total cost of 13,543.44 DM.
 - c. On 14 July 1951, through the rolling mill of Kayser** at 9/11 Fliesstrasse, Berlin-Niederschonenweide, from Expresso** S.A Geneva, a total of 30,400 kg of recast lead at an authorized price of 19.80 DM per percentage kg or a total cost of 5,979.20 DM.
 - d. On 11 June, 29 June and 7 July 1951, from Expresso, **Zurich, a total of 49,230 kg of metallurgic soft lead, 99.9 percent pure, at an authorized price of 23.10 DM per percentage kg plus a 2 percent commission or a total cost of 11,599.57 DM.
 - e. On 28 June 1951, from Expresso** Geneva, a total of 18,060 kg of metallurgic soft lead in ingots, 99.9 percent pure, at an authorized price of 23.10 DM per percentage kg plus a 2-percent commission or a total cost of 4,255.30 DM.
