SUBJECT Standardized Curricula for all Military and Political Universities in China for 1951 25X1A

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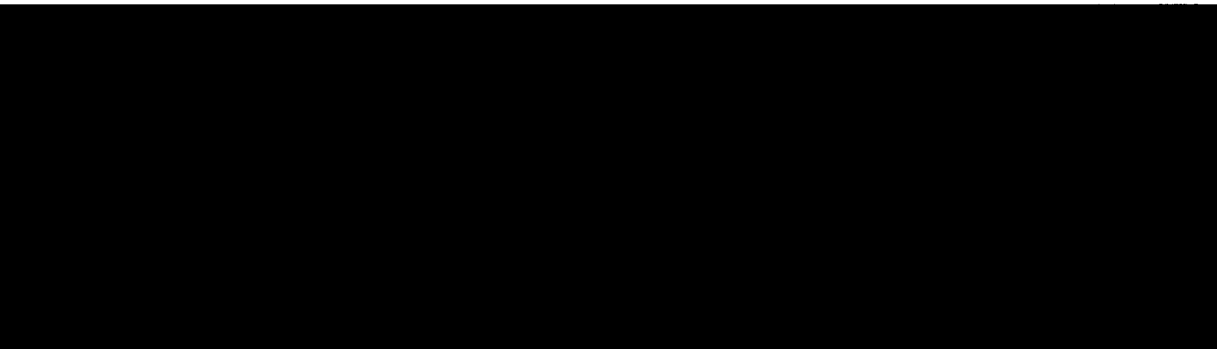
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SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.



1. On 20 April 1951, a document was issued by the General Political Section of the Military Committee which stated that the curricula of the various military and political universities in China would be standardized for the year 1951.¹ These instructions were to be adopted by all military and political universities which come under the control of the Military Committee and the various military districts. A military district political commissar or a military district commander will be president of each university. YEH Chien-ying is president of the Canton Branch School of the Central and South China Military and Political University, and HSIAO Hsiang-jung (蕭向榮) is vice president.
2. The following is an explanation of the organization system of the universities:
 - a. The Education and Supervision Department is headed by the Political Section Chief, whose position is directly under the president and corresponds to the dean.
 - b. The University Administration Committee is headed by the President of the University. This is the highest administrative body of the university which includes representatives of professors, students, staffs, and laborers. Under this committee there are the (a) Cultural Workers' Group, (b) Extra-Curriculum Committee, (c) Sanitation Committee, and (d) General Affairs Department.
 - c. The chairman of the Life Supervision Committee is elected by the University Party Committee.
 - d. The members of the United Examining and Auditing Committee are chosen from the Supervisory members of the University Party Committee. No administrative personnel may become members of this committee.
 - e. The Training Department is headed by the Deputy Chief of the Political Section.

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f. The Research Department personnel are chosen from among the professors.

g. At present the Canton Branch School of the Central and South Military and Political University has four student Ta Tui or big groups. Each Ta Tui has three Chung Tui, or medium groups, and each Chung Tui has over 100 students.

3. Political Curricula (Compulsory)

a. History of Social Development, including ancient and modern history.

b. Basic Principles of the Chinese Revolution, including the present stage of Chinese revolution in the historical period, the social foundation of the Chinese revolution, and the duty, nature, momentum and leadership of the present stage.

c. History and basic experiences of the revolution of Chinese new democratic principles.

d. Establishment of new democratic principles.

(1) The people's democratic administration and the economic system of the new democratic principles.

(2) Organization of the new Chinese regime and the military system.

(3) The economic establishment of New China.

(4) The cultural establishment of New China.

(5) New China is a friendly cooperative family of all races.

(6) The international standing and duty of New China.

(7) The bright future for New China--Socialism and Communism.

e. Items (a) and (b) require a learning period of three and one-half months. Item (c) requires four and one-half months. Item (d) requires four months, making a total of a year. In addition, Revolutionary Philosophy and Materialism must also be studied. News Education is a supplementary course. Business and Work Education have not been arranged by the Military Committee. These will be decided on by the various military districts according to local needs.

f. The one month period for studying the United Front provides the special education which includes the following: The Three Great Laws of Revolutionary Victory, The Basic Principles of the Communist Regime, The Consolidation and Expansion of the United Front, the Leading Authorities of the Communist Regime, The Surrender Principle of the Pro-Rightist and the Closed Door Principle of the Pro-Leftist, and the People's Democratic Administration.

h. The Military curriculum will include field, combat, and arms education; the nature and duty of the Army, discussions of the battlefields of the occupied areas, an introduction of the historical battles of the Army, the struggle by force and tactics of the Pu Erh Shih Wei K'uo (布尔什维克) Party (Bolshevik), and a digest of the combat techniques and tactics of warfare.
