SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

1. An underground factory was being constructed in July a short distance northeast of the paper factory on the banks of the Yalu, north of Sinuiju. Products to be manufactured were undetermined. A railroad bridge across the Yalu, just under the surface of the water, was used in July by trains which crossed from Sinuiju to Antung three times daily.
2. An underground warehouse was at the southwest end of an orchard one kilometer southwest of Sinwon station (125-44, 38-13) (YC 3933). The entrance was large enough to permit a truck to enter, and the capacity of the warehouse was 2,000 bags of rice. In July, it contained artillery pieces, mortars, machine guns, and ammunition.
3. In late July, about 2,000 straw bags of wheat, potatoes, unhulled rice, and refined rice were being moved daily from Paekch'on hot spring (126-13, 37-59) (BT 6307) to Haeju. The cars passed through Pongsŏ (126-07, 37-54) (BS 4798) about 3:00 a.m. each morning.
