(Monopolul Alcoolului Si Tutunului - Department for Alcohol and Tobacco) is attached to the Ministry of Food Industry and designed to handle industrial state enterprises for the production and sale of alcohol, wine and their by-products. Until 1 October 1949 M.A.T. was only responsible for the collection and the sale of the above products. On that date the Centrala was analgamated with the Centrala Industriala A Produselor Alcoalice Si De Fermentare (Industrial Centre for Alcoholic Products and Fermentation), and thus took over production responsibility also. III. Output and Prices of Production.

- 1. Output: The factories and installations for alcohol have a theoretical capacity of 4000 "wagons" yearly. In 1949 the production fixed by the Plan, of 2,500 "wagons" was reached. Of these 2,000 were used locally and 500 were exported. But in 1950 the production fixed by the Plan, of 3,000 "wagons," was not reached, according to source, who believes this was the fault of "the drought."
- 2. Price of the Products.

The net cost of the alcohol is 120 Lei per liter (58 Lei cost of production and 62 Lei cost of administration). It is sold on the local market at a price of 600 Lei per liter.

In 1949 alcohol was sold to the Russians at a price of 18 American cents a liter. This price was lower than prices on the world market and much lower than the net cost of production.
