A workshop for the namufacturing of dummies used for target practice was also housed in the castle. A bombing range has existed since 1948 and was 1 to 4 km east of Ronafoe. Five control towers were located on two edges of the bombing range and connected by telephone lines with the castle. Dummies representing tanks, aircraft, guns, trains, railroad embandments, bridges, and fire trenches were trucked from Ronafoe to the bombing range.
	Source observed that twin-engine bombers flying in three flights of three planes each appeared daily about 9 a.m. if the weather was favorable. The aircraft approached the targets three or four times, releasing bombs on each approach. The next group practiced bombing about half an hour later. During the interval, a single-engine reconnaissance plane appeared and probably took photographs of the results. According to local residents, the bombers came from Austria.
