1. On 21 and 22 September 1951, the collective billeting area of the Alte Kaserne and the Neue Kaserne in Parchim (M 54/T 74) was occupied by only a rear unit of about 150 soldiers, who wore red-bordered black epaulets, including some with tank insignia. *
2. The municipal home for aged people is on Sirikoerstrasse, east of the cemetery. It consists of a four-story main building, about 45 meters long, two stables and one barn. The installation is surrounded by a board fence, 2 meters high, and houses a Soviet administrative office. Two officers and 10 EM with red-bordered black epaulets were observed there. **
