1. No Soviet troop trains passed through the Schone border railroad station between 2 and 20 September 1951.
2. No Soviet troop trains passed through the Kuestrin-Neustadt border railroad station between 13 and 19 September.
3. The following numbers of Soviet military personnel were observed aboard leave trains in Frankfurt/Oder between 21 and 24 September:

Date	To Brest Litovsk	From Brest Litovsk
21 September	80 and 70	180 and 200
22 September	60 and 80	200 and 250
23 September	70 and 80	280 and 240
24 September	60 and 50	230 and 280 (1)
4. A daily quota of 195 boxcars and 600 flatcars for troop trains were furnished by and dispatched from the Magdeburg railroad district on 24 and 25 September. (2)
5. Eastbound troop trains carrying air force units, possibly ground personnel, and disassembled wooden barracks, which came from Leipzig and passed through Frankfurt/Oder, included: a train of 24 boxcars and 22 flatcars, shipment-record No 14750, on 22 September; a train of 24 boxcars and 19 flatcars, shipment-record No 14751, on 23 September; and a train of 23 boxcars and 25 flatcars, shipment-record No 14752, on 24 September. Each boxcar was occupied by about 30 soldiers. (3)
6. Westbound rail shipments of Russian girls observed at the Frankfurt/Oder railroad station included: 15 cars on 19 September, 15 cars on 25 September, and 15 cars on 28 September. (4)

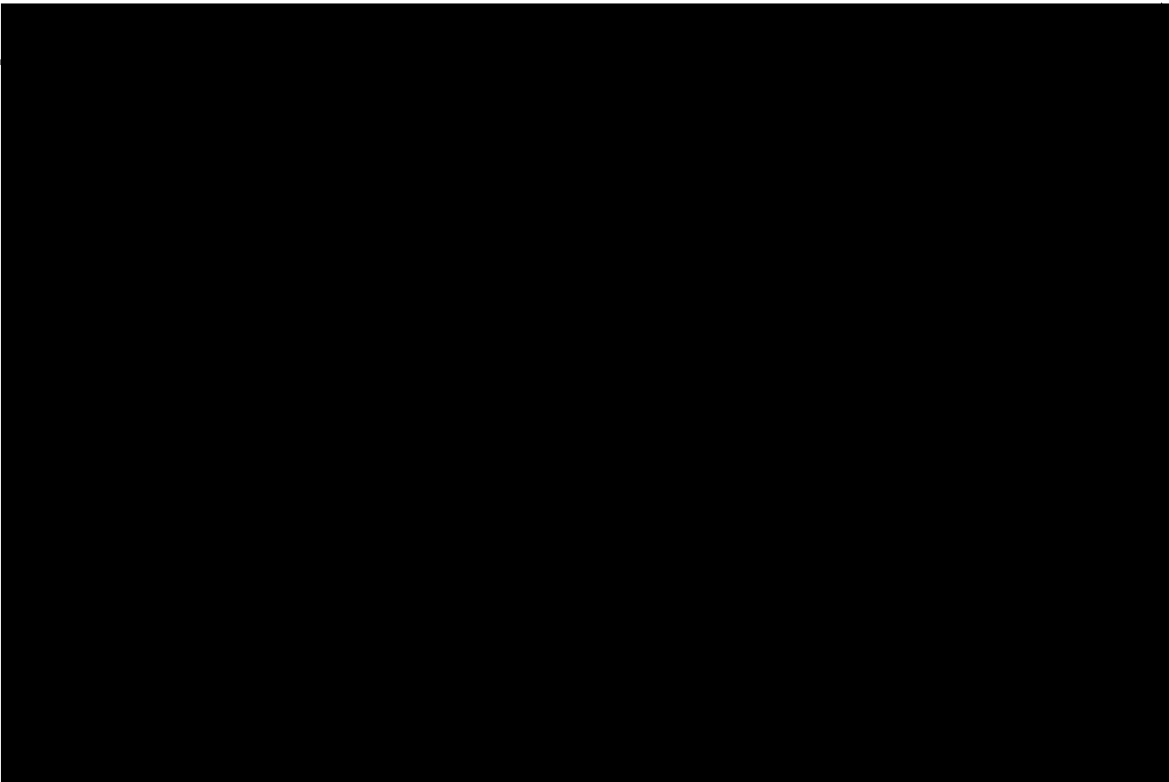
