(Fnu) Souhilin of the Soviet trade office of Stankolmport, Brunnenstrasse, East Berlin has ordered 20 Palfrich-photometers from Zeins-Jena. Delivery was to be made during the first week of October 1951. Tishchenko of the Soviet Trade Delegation in East Berlin told Weiss-Jena authorities to prepare to receive an order for 79 A-1 P devices with twenty spare-parts kits. This order is to be fulfilled by Zeiss on a priority basis during 1952. It is to be charged to the 1952 Soviet account at Zeiss and is to be handled as a straight export contract through DIA and not as a reperations contract. Tishchenko exhibited extreme impatience until he was assured that the delivery would be made. He was informed that Zeiss could accept the contract in principle, but that formal agreement on the terms of the contract would have to be delayed until the end of the first week in October 1951.\* Tyrolf of the DDM Staatssekretariat für Materialversorgung informed Zeiss-Jena that the latter was to be given a contract for export to the USSR of diamond dies from .3 to .5 caratt, 50 Mu hore. Tyrolf stated that the Staatssekree tariat für Materialversorgung will provide the raw diamonds. Deliveries are scheduled as follows: 1951: 6,400 1952: 41,000 visited Zelss-Jena on 28 September 1951 to place an order for 15 sound-movie-projectors. The price was listed as 6,000 DM East per projector, and Major Nilyubin was promised immediate delivery. 5. At the end of September 1951, the Reparations Division of the Thuringian Land Government was impatiently pressing Zeiss-Jena for the immediate delivery of one universal exception, to enter into direct postal communication with

- 6. Ors. Köhler, Zöllner, Lukas and Hartwig of Zeiss-Jena are to travel to the Satellite countries during October and November 1951 to give lectures on subjects related to the science of optics. In the course of this lecture tour they are to appear in mid-November at the industrial fair which will be held in Bucharest.
- 7. Wang, the head of the Chinese Trade Delegation in Berlin, recently stated that another group of Chinese would arrive in East Germany in November 1951 to negotiate an additional trade agreement covering 1952 and 1953 between the DDR and China, and that Zeiss would receive a portion of the orders placed under this agreement.
