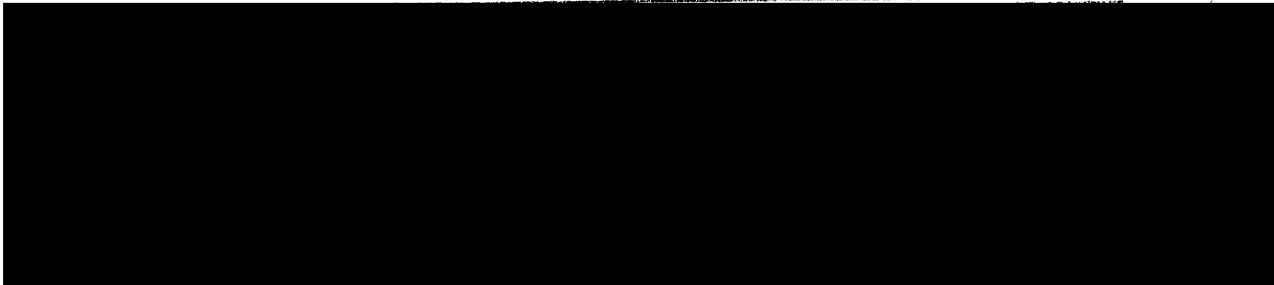

Comment: The daily loading quota seems to have been increased from 22,000 to 23,000 cars. It is noteworthy that the actual loading performance has exceeded this new quota during the week but not on Sundays. The number of railroad cars required by the Soviet occupation power has risen considerably over that used in the previous week. See SO-73128x.

Comment: Compared with the preceding week the loading performance has risen slightly. Traffic of the occupation power has again declined to the previously observed normal level, except on 22 August. As usual, the loading performance on Sunday, 2 September, was much smaller than on weekdays.

* Comment: In comparison with the previous week, there has been little change in the loading performances and the number of cars claimed by the occupation power.

**** Comment: As compared with the previous week, both the loading performances and the numbers of cars required by the Occupation Power have risen considerably.
