- In early September 1951, 30,000 Chinese Communist troops were sent to south Fukien from the Foochow area.
- 2. On 20 September, two additional regiments arrived in north Fukien. They are stationed near the Peiling ( ) Mountains, Lienchiang (119-31, 26-12), and Lofou (120-03, 26-41), probably to strengthen coastal defenses.
- 3. Chinese Communist forces in south Fukien are again issuing propaganda saying they will soon liberate Nankantang (資字液) and Paitatao (白大岛) of the Chinmen Island group.
