Bad Voelau (O 48/X 36)	24 September 1951	Occupation: 23 Po-2s and 3 LI-2s. No flying. [redacted] 25X1X
Parndorf (P 48/X 77)	26 September 1951	Occupation: 17 fighters with radial engines, 1 fighter with an in-line engine. A total of 12 trucks, 3 tank trucks, 6 van-like trucks, and 2 prime movers. [redacted] 25X1X
Wiener-Neustadt (O 48/X 35)	29 September 1951	Occupation: 29 jet fighters and 21 single-engine fighters. Former officer candidate school in Fischau (O 48/X 34) occupied by soldiers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets. [redacted] * 25X1X

* Comment: The number of aircraft at Wiener-Neustadt airfield has decreased by 12 jet fighters since 13 September 1951. [redacted]. It is not known whether the 12 aircraft were flying on 29 September or whether they were only temporarily stationed at the field on 13 September 1951.
