The cards are not completely distributed but are kept in local army offices. Army units are constructing pillboxes and shelters along the road between Petrich and Kolarevo (QK-0723). At the village of Kozuh along the Petrich-Shirbanovo road, underground POL dumps have been established. In this area there are gun emplacements and many military guards. Mear the eastern edge of Sveti Vrach, there are approximately 80 civilians One-half of 2 Battalion of 14 Macedonian Infantry Regiment was transferred from Svretnovitch (sic) to Kresna (QK-1669). 5. A border guard detachment of approximately 200 soldiers moved from Svretnovitch to Petrich. In the Petrich area there are approximately 80 soldiers with trained dogs for the pursuit of border crossers. 6. There are no anti-Communist organizations in the Gara Pirin or Ograzhden areas.
