HSU Tse-ch'iao (统章 统), who is also known by his given name, Tse-ch'iao, director of the wartime and postwar activities of a Chinese Communist Party intelligence unit in Manila, is now in Penang, Malaya, where he is on a clandestine assignment of an undetermined nature for the Chinese Communist Party.1 HSU's Penang address is 42 or 49 Victoria Road. His younger brother is 2. a successful automotive dealer in Penang. FSU, who is approximately 30 years of age, left Manila between April and August 1950 for Hong Kong. He went to China subsequently and applied to the Chinese Communist Party for a position in Fukien. This application was rejected, and HSU was sent to Pinang on an assignment for the Party. In addition to WAN Yuan-ming, LIN Sou-hai, and WU Fang-yuan, former members of HSU's unit who are still in Manila, CH'EN Lien-sung (京東 月井 本), who is approximately AO and a native of Chinchiang, Fukien, formerly worked for HSU. CHI'M resides in Manila on the premises of the Central Home Furnishing Company, 375-377 Echague Street, Quiapo.2 There are no indications that any of HSU's former agents in Manila are now engaged in Communist activity. 25X1A Comment. which this report supplements, referred to MSU by his given name and described his activities as a Chinese Communist agent in Manila prior to April 1950.
