1. In early May 1951, 12 Soviet TU-4 jet planes landed at a Sofia airport. Subsequently, the planes took off and flew in the direction of Stara Zagora.
2. The Bulgarian Red Cross has been placed under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Defense and has established medical centers throughout the country. Sanitation battalions are attached to the medical centers.
