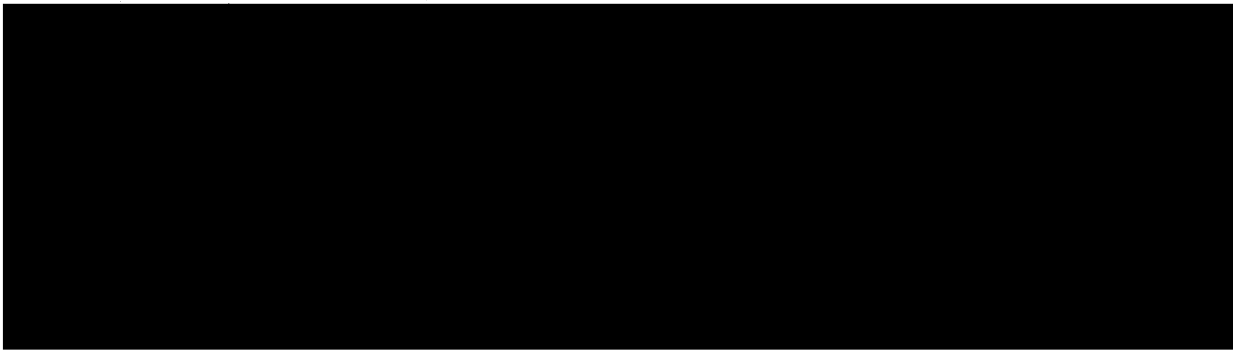

1. The 201 Antitank Artillery Regiment, which is reportedly stationed at Kiseljak, approximately 40 kilometers east of Sarajevo, is equipped as follows:

a. 40 antitank artillery pieces, 7 centimeters in caliber. [REDACTED] 25X1X
unable to ascertain whether these artillery pieces were of British or American manufacture; however, the gun carriages are drawn by trucks of British manufacture.

b. All of the equipment of the 201 Antitank Artillery Regiment was new and extremely up-to-date.

2. The 475 Artillery Regiment, which is reportedly stationed at Dervonta, about 80 kilometers south of Bosanski Brod, is equipped with:

a. 30 mountain artillery pieces, the gun carriages of which are drawn by trucks of American origin.

3. An unidentified tank brigade is stationed in Obrenovac, approximately 40 kilometers west of Belgrade. The [REDACTED]

25X1B [REDACTED] This brigade is equipped with: 25X1B

a. Approximately 70 T-34 tanks of Soviet origin. Whenever these tanks are in need of repairs, they are sent to the repair shop at Kragujevac.

4. The headquarters command and two unspecified battalions of the 6 Rifle Regiment under the command of Major Balaban, are located at Kumanovo. Each battalion in this Regiment has one rifle company. An artillery battalion, composed of three batteries, is attached to the 6 Rifle Regiment. Two of these batteries are equipped with Soviet antitank artillery pieces 7.62 centimeters in caliber, and antitank guns of smaller caliber also of Russian make, while the remaining battery is equipped with Russian 120-millimeter mortars.
