1. The Petar Drapsin factory is located in Sremska Ulica 15, Novi Sad. It is enclosed with a wire net about 2.5 meters high placed on a wall one meter high. All the buildings are of masonry construction and painted dark grey.
2. The factory manufactures all types of screws of iron, copper and aluminum; screws for metal and lumber. In one of the buildings of the factory, enclosed with a separate wall, is a factory producing all kinds of wire nets of iron and steel.
3. The capacity of the factory is two carloads of screws monthly; however, because of a lack of spare parts for machines and raw materials, the present production is one carload a month.
4. The director of the factory is Luka Jankovic. Approximately 500 workers are employed in the enterprise, 300 of them in the screws factory and 200 in the wire factory.
5. The Fabeks nail factory, located in Novi Sad, is under the management of the Petar Drapsin factory. This factory manufactures 5 millimeter nails exclusively and the monthly capacity is 1,000 kilograms.
6. The enterprise is equipped with the following machines:
 - a. Mechanical and machinery department:
 - 4 large boring machines of German origin with electric motors.
 - 6 automatic machines to cut raw material, German origin, with electric motors.
 - 6 scrapers of German origin, with electric motors.
 - 4 scrapers of German origin, moved by transmission.
 - 4 planes of German origin with electric motors.
 - 2 electric saws for iron.
