

- There have been several air raid alarms in Foochow as a result of flights of United States planes along the coast of that area. On 6 October 1951, three anti-aircraft guns of Soviet manufacture arrived in Foochow and were immediately emplaced in the harbor area.
- 2. Heavy machinery and supplies in the warehouses in the dock area of Mawei (119-26, 25-59) have been moved to inland warehouses.
- All fishing vessels in the Foochow area have been organized into units to facilitate their use as combat vessels in an emergency.
- All civilians without proper authorization from the military authorities have been forbidden entry to the military zones of the Foochow area.
