SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

- In mid-September CHANG I-min (旅 義 成 )1, a purchasing agent for the Democratic Republic of Vietnam, arrived in Hong Kong and took accommodations at the Ta Chung Hua (大 中 華) Hotel, Connaught Road, Central, He dealt with the Hsin Yun Hong (新 建 行), second floor, 140 Connaught Road, Central, for the purchase of carbon are large medicated. purchase of carbon arc lamps, medicines, and drugs.
- 2. As of early October, LO Lung-chi (羅 程基) was responsible for the Chinese Communist international liaison bureau in Hong Kong. Among his contacts have been CH EN Chin-sha ( ) ), several representatives of Communist labor organizations in South Africa, and many overseas Chinese from Malaya. LO has been planning to make an organizing trip to Southeast Asia.
- 3. OU-YANG Shan (民 為山)3, head of the Culture and Education Committee for South China, has ordered HO Choun-ying (何 英 文), a female cultural agent, to Hong Kong to prepare for the arrival in Hong Kong of TS'UI Ts'ai-1 (崔 永 文), director of the Cultural and Science Department (sic) of the Chinese Communist Government. TS UI arrived in Canton about 7 October.
- CHUANG Toien (在日)4 has sent FEI Hsiao-tung (青春頃)5 and CHOU Yung-yin (周蒙吟) as agents to the Democratic Republic of Vietnam (DRV). CHUANG's liaison center in Hong Kong is in the Wan I (萬益)6 Shop on the first floor of Hong Kong Ta Kung Ssu (大公司).
- The South China Bureau has sent CH'EN Wei-tz'u (旗殿 慈) to Hong Kong to supervise Communist agents. He often goes to the Hua Ch'iao (華 篇) Trading Company 114 Des Voeux Road.
- TENG Fei (資 非), also known as TENG Liang (管 良 ), has returned to Hong Kung after a period of training in Canton. He was formerly a chief Communist agent in the Colony. He frequents the Chung Chiang (中 法) Dispensary, 796 Nathan Road.

- The Hua Nan ( ) Auto Company 6, fourth floor, 5 Des Voeux Road is a Chinese Communist espionage center and a purchasing station for war materials for Communist China.
- The Nan Hua (南 章 ) Manufacturing Company9 of Horr Kong has received an order for 500 junk engines and 500 automobile engines from the Chinese Communists.
- Comment. The Vietnamese equivalent is Truong Di Dan. 25X1A
- 25X1A Comment. Presumably this would be the Great China Hotel, 119 Connaught Road, Central.
- 25X1A Comment. According to information available to this office, OU-YANG Shan has previously held positions as a member of the Culture and Education Committee for Central and South China and as chief of the Canton branch of the Sino-Soviet Friendship Association.
- 25X1A 25X1A CHUANG has pre-Comment. According to viously held important positions in Chinese Communist military missions to the DRV.
- 25X1A Comment. According to information available to this office, FEI Hsiao-tung, a prominent Chinese anthropologist, has previously been employed by the Chinese Communists as an emissary to the YAO people of Kwangsi. The assignment here reported may be a similar one.
- 25X1A Comment. In Hong Kong, such a name would probably be rendered Man Yik.
- 25X1A Comment. According to information available to this office, CH'EN was active in April 1951 in the Hua Ch'iac or Overseas Chinese Trading Company. This company was engaged in procurement of material for the Chinese Communists and cornering foreign exchange.

- Comment. Presumably this is Hua Nan Motors, Fed. Inc. U.S.A., of the same address, who are authorized dealers for De Soto automobiles in Hong 25X1X ■ Hua Nan Motors is a subsidiary of the Union Investment Company of Hong Kong.
- 25X1A 9. Comment. This may be the Nan Hua Ironworks, reported in as supplying Diesel engines for junks being fitted at Whampoa.
